The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick within Mass will take place on Tuesday, 11 February at 6:30 p.m., the feast day of Our Lady of Lourdes: the World Day of Prayer for the Sick in Immaculate Conception Church. This Mass will be broadcast LIVE on our Facebook page: Tri-Parish of Heatherton Pomquet St. Andrews. The sacrament of Anointing if the Sick is rooted in scripture: James 5:13-15: "Is anyone among you suffering? He should pray. Is anyone in good spirits? He should sing praise. Is anyone among you sick? He should summon the priests of the church, and they should pray over him and anoint [him] with oil in the name of the Lord, and the prayer of faith will save the sick person, and the Lord will raise him up. If he has committed any sins, he will be forgiven."

WHO MAY BE ANOINTED?

Baptized members of the Christian faithful who have reached the age of reason and who due to serious illness or old age. *Participation in the Sacrament of the Sick is encouraged broadly. For example:*

- The elderly who are weakened, even though no notable illness is present, may choose to participate in the ritual.
- Those who face surgery due to serious illness or whose serious health conditions worsens
- Those who suffer serious mental illness

All are welcome to attend this Mass. Anyone who is unable to attend may request the Sacrament anytime by contacting Fr. Andrew
