<u>PICK-UP AND DELIVERY SERVICE:</u> This group is currently in a position to offer a pick-up and delivery service, for prepaid groceries, health care products, prescriptions, income taxes, etc. Should anyone in the Tri Parish require this service, call the Tri-parish office at 902-386-2810, **between 1:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Monday - Friday only.** This is a free service being offered by volunteers from the Tri-Parish. As this service does not include the transportation of people (due to Covid-19), should you require transportation please call Antigonish Community Transit book a ride at 902-867-0411.

KEEPING IN TOUCH SERVICE: There are some people in the Tri-Parish who might be living alone, have no family in the area to have a chat with or simply no one to talk to.
