

Bottle Refundables for Emiliani Project in Colombia: Thanks to the Wishing Well Foundations for letting the Monsignor Hugh MacPherson Knights of Columbus take over their bottle recyclable program earlier this year. The Monsignor Hugh MacPherson Knights of Columbus have decided to assign the proceeds of this initiative to the Emiliani Project, an orphanage in Colombia, that Father Andrew and a team of parishioner's have visited for a number of years to assist with the orphanage's expansion program. When complete the orphanage will be home to 160 children without families, ages 1 to adult. The waiting list to get into the home is double that. All these children have been abused to the point where some of them have to be sent to a more specialized facility. To date, and thanks to you, the Monsignor Hugh MacPherson Knights of Columbus have collected approximately \$2,300.00 Canadian, which we have just decided to send to the orphanage to assist with their expansion plans. Thank you to everyone who continues to drop off their refundables (drop off location has moved to the side of the church in St Andrew's) and please spread the word that we are doing this, so that we may continue to help get more children out of poverty.
