
Doors Open for Churches: Virtual Guided Tours of Places of Worship



Pope Francis instituted the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which will take place each year on the fourth Sunday in July, close to the feast of Saints Joachim and Anne, Jesus' grandparents.
